The first day of filing is Monday, November 27, 2017. The last day of filing is Monday, December 4, 2017 and our office will be open until 5:00 p.m. Those nominating petitions received after 8:30 a.m. and before 4:30 p.m. during the filing period will be stamped according to the time received. Petitions received prior to the first day and after the last day of filing will be returned to the prospective candidate.

Kane County Election Authority

OFFICE:

COUNTY OFFICERS -COUNTY CLERKS, TREASURERS, SHERIFF, ASSESSOR*, COMMISSIONERS, COUNTY BOARD MEMBERS, BOARD OF REVIEW MEMBERS (in some counties), AND REGIONAL SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS**.

The number of countywide executive offices varies from county to county. For example, some counties do not elect the office of assessor. All counties do, however, elect such officers as county clerk, treasurer, sheriff, state's attorney, county board members or commissioners, recorder, and circuit clerk. Approximately half of a county's officers are elected every two years.

Note: a person is not eligible to be elected or appointed to the office of sheriff unless that person is a U.S. citizen, has been a resident of the county for at least one year and is not a convicted felon. (55 ILCS 5/3-6001.5)

RESIDENCY:

United States citizen. Resident of the county for 30 days. Registered voter in the county or county board district. (10 ILCS 5/7-10, 10-5)

NOTE: In counties with a population of 3,000,000 or less, no person is eligible to hold the office of **county board member or commissioner** unless that person is a legal voter and has been a resident of the county for at least one year next preceding the election. (55 ILCS 5/2-3015)

NOTE: In Cook County, the candidate must have been a resident of the County Board District which the candidate seeks to represent for at least two years prior to election or appointment. (Section 22-31, Cook County Code of Ordinances)

SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS:

ESTABLISHED PARTY CANDIDATES

For all offices (including Chairman of the County Board and county board members elected from the county at large), petitions must be signed by at least .5% (.005) of the vote cast for the candidate of his/her party who received the highest number of votes in the county at the 2016 general election. The party candidate with the highest vote in the county could be any federal, state or county candidate. (Note: The actual number is generally compiled by the election authority. Contact your election authority for further information.)

[10 ILCS 5/7-10(c)]

For offices elected by district, at least .5% (.005) of the number of primary electors of his/her party in the district who cast votes at the last preceding general election (determined by the number of votes received by the candidate of each political party who received the highest number of votes in the district at the last regular election at which an officer was scheduled to be elected from that district; the candidate with the highest number of votes could be federal, state, or county candidate). The actual number is compiled by the election authority.

INDEPENDENT CANDIDATES

An Independent candidate for county office (including Chairman of the County Board and county board members elected from the county at large) must submit nomination papers signed by qualified voters of the county equaling not less than 5%, nor more than 8% (or 50 more than the minimum, whichever is greater) of the <u>number of persons</u> who voted at the **LAST** general election in the county or county board district (for county board district, the **LAST** time the district elected a member). (10 ILCS 5/10-3)

NEW PARTY CANDIDATES

A petition to form a new political party for countywide offices shall contain a complete list of candidates of such party for all offices (including all county board districts) to be filled at the election.

Not less than 5% of the <u>number of persons</u> who voted at the next preceding general election in the county or for a county board district the last time the district elected a member. Where 5% is greater than 25,000, 25,000 is the minimum number of signatures required. (The actual number of signatures required is compiled by your election authority. Contact your election authority for more information). (10 ILCS 5/10-2)

New party candidates seeking county office with officers elected by district and at-large shall file petitions consisting of separate components for each district from which an officer is to be elected. Each component shall be circulated only within a district of the political subdivision and signed only by qualified electors who are residents of such district. Each sheet of such petition must contain a complete list of the names of the candidates of the party for all offices to be filled in the political subdivision at large, but the sheets comprising each component shall also contain the names of those candidates to be elected from the particular district. Each component of the petition for each district from which an officer is to be elected must be signed by qualified voters of the district equaling in number not less than 5% of the number of voters who voted at the next preceding regular election in such district at which an officer was elected to serve the district. The entire petition, including all components, must be signed by a total of qualified voters of the entire political subdivision equaling in number not less than 5% of the number of voters who voted at the next preceding regular election in such political subdivision at which an officer was elected to serve the political subdivision at large. (10 ILCS 5/10-2)

TERM OF OFFICE: 4 Years and until a successor is elected and qualified.

Exception: County Commissioner term is 6-years and until a successor is elected and qualified, except for Cook County Commissioners, whose terms are 4-years.

County Commissioners are elected at-large in certain downstate counties. County Board Members and Commissioners may be elected at-large and from districts.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- * A candidate for ASSESSOR must possess one of the following qualifications as certified by the individual to the county clerk. (35 ILCS 200/3-5, 3-45, 3-50). A Certified Illinois Assessing Official Certificate, A Certified Assessment Evaluator Certificate, a member of the Appraisal Institute or twelve years' experience or more and a Certified Illinois Assessing Official Certificate. In addition, a person must have had at least 2 years' experience in the field of property sales, assessments, finance or appraisals and must have passed an examination conducted by the Department of Revenue.
- ** A candidate for REGIONAL SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS must possess a master's degree and certain other educational qualifications that are listed in 105 ILCS 5/3-1. No other petition of any candidate for nomination for the office of Regional Superintendent of Schools may be filed and no such

candidate's name may be placed on a primary or general election ballot, unless such candidate files as part of his/her petition, a certificate from the State Board of Education certifying that from the records of its office such candidate has the qualifications required by this section; however, any incumbent filing his/her petition for nomination for a succeeding term of office shall not be required to attach such certificate to his/her petition. Candidates for Regional Superintendent of Schools should examine the provisions of Section 3-1 carefully in order to determine if they qualify.

NOTE: Nomination petitions for **Established Party** regional superintendent of school candidates in multi-county districts will be accepted only in the principal office of the State Board of Elections located at 2329 S. MacArthur Blvd., Springfield, Illinois 62704-4503, **no sooner than November 27, 2017 and no later than December 4, 2017.** The signature requirements for the various multi-county regions are located in the signature chart at the end of this publication.

The State Board of Elections will accept nomination petitions for regional superintendent of school candidates <u>only in multi-county districts</u>. Candidates seeking to file nomination petitions for regional superintendent of schools in single member districts should contact their local election authority for information concerning signature requirements and filing dates and times.
