This calendar includes dates pertinent for the **March 19, 2024 General Primary (GP)** and **November 5, 2024 General Election (GE)**, as well as for the **February 25, 2025 Consolidated Primary (CP)** and **April 1, 2025 Consolidated Election (CE)**. **Dates for the 2025 Consolidated Election are subject to change depending on whether the February 2025 Consolidated Primary Election will be necessary. Please be advised that all dates listed in this calendar are tentative and can be changed by the state legislature at any time.**

The units of government involved in the election are listed on the calendar backing. I hope this calendar will be helpful to you in your civic activities during the upcoming election periods.

This calendar is intended to provide general guidance and is subject to change. More information is available on the County Clerk's website as well as the State Board of Elections website. **Candidates or organizations that have specific questions should seek the guidance of competent legal counsel because the County Clerk's office is not permitted to provide legal advice.**

### WHAT ARE JUDGES OF ELECTION?

Judges of elections are responsible for the administration of election procedures in the polling place on Election Day. They are in the position of ensuring that the election process is administered fairly and in accordance with the law.

### WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATIONS TO BE AN ELECTION JUDGE?

Be a citizen of the United States • Be of good repute and character and not subject to the registration requirement of the Sex Offender Registration Act • Be able to speak, read, and write the English language; • Be skilled in the four fundamental rules of mathematics

- Be of good understanding and capable
- Has satisfactorily completed the training course for judges of election
- Not be a candidate for any office in the election and not be elected committeeman
- Reside in and be entitled to vote in the precinct where selected to serve as judge.

All judges must be electors within Kane County.

### WHAT ARE SOME OF THE DUTIES OF THE JUDGES OF ELECTION?

To open and close the polls • To be responsible for all election materials; • To ensure that only qualified voters are permitted to vote and that each qualified voter is permitted to vote once and only once; • To ensure that all votes are cast in secret; • To give instructions in the method of voting when requested by a voter • To give assistance to illiterate and physically disabled voters • To maintain order in the polling place throughout the day • To tally the vote after the polls are closed; and to certify the election results in that precinct.

### HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS MAY SERVE AS JUDGES WITH THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:

Is a citizen of the United States; • Is a junior or senior in good standing enrolled in a public or private secondary school, or is a student currently enrolled in community college or a public or private Illinois university or college • If currently enrolled in a secondary school, has the written approval of both the principal and a parent or legal guardian • Has a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale • Has satisfactorily completed the training course for judges of election • Meets all other qualifications for appointment and service as an election judge.

## Improvements to the Current System

- Touch screen voting
- Printed paper ballot produced
- Added security protection and auditing capabilities
- More transparency
- Improved accessibility features for voters with disabilities
- Increased efficiency

## Similar Process to Current Voting Machines

- 1. Voter checks in at precinct.
- 2. Voter given access code to enter at booth to pull up their ballot style.
- 3. Voter enters access code onto Verity Duo device using touch screen system rather than “Wheel” and “Enter” button.
- 4. Voter inserts a piece of paper into voting machine.
- 5. Voter makes choices on screen and then have chance to review choices before printing final ballot.
- 6. Voter prints final ballot that will be then fed into the Verity Scanner to finish their voting process.
